WV TRiO State Meeting Minutes
Blennerhassett Hotel
Parkersburg, WV
November 4, 2015
4:10 pm

- I. Call to Order – WV TRiO Association Vivian Céspedes called the meeting to order at 4:15pm
 - A. Appointment of Parliamentarian – Angela Holley from Marshall University
 - B. Establish Quorum – 23 people were in attendance, and a quorum was formed
 - C. Appointment of Secretary – Betty Mei from West Virginia University
 - D. A Sign-In Sheet was circulated.
 - E. Members in attendance introduced themselves, as well as programs and schools they represented.
Nicole Norfles from COE was also in attendance.
- II. Approval of Agenda – Jennifer Bunner made the motion, and Tim Young seconded it to approve the agenda additions and table the minutes.
- III. Approval of Minutes (Was tabled)
- IV. Executive Board Reports
 - A. President - Vivian Céspedes
 - President Céspedes gave the members in attendance a copy of the Executive Board report. (See Attached).
 - B. President-Elect - Scott Robertson
 - President-Elect Robertson informed members that the WV TRiO Association had received a \$20,000 grant from the Higher Education Policy Commission for the 2016 Student Leadership Conference.
 - C. Immediate Past President - Carol Suder-Howes
 - Immediate Past President Suder-Howes was not in attendance due to illness. President Céspedes spoke on her behalf and informed members that the tax exempt status (501C) of WV TRiO had been reinstated. The accountant who helped with the process did not charge the association any expenses. A check of \$431 will be written to the state by the end of this week to incorporate the association.
 - D. Treasurer - Nick Bedway
 - Treasurer Bedway was not in attendance due to teaching. President Céspedes gave members in attendance a copy of the Treasurer's report, and informed members that the current account would be closed as soon as all checks have been cleared. A new account will be opened under a new name "West Virginia TRiO Association." President-Elect Robertson reported for Treasurer Bedway (see attached report), and informed members that from this year's state conference, a profit of \$6,000-6,500 had been made for the association.
- V. Standing Committee Reports
 - A. TRiO Achievers/Alumni – Carol Suder-Howes: Not in attendance
 - B. Scholarships – Cynthia Copney: Not in attendance; however, President-Elect Robertson will discuss future scholarship application deadlines and disbursement methods with chairperson Copney and Betty Mei, who is a long-time member on the scholarship committee. For the 2015 year, there was some confusion as to when the scholarship checks would be disbursed. The Executive Board had

discussed that recognitions needed to be given to the scholarship recipients either through the local media or school newsletters to give the WV TRiO Association press attention. Members were encouraged to help their students to apply for the state TRiO scholarships as well as the MEAEOPP Scholarships. A suggestion was made for the scholarship committee to give out application information early to avoid late submissions due to snow days in the winter.

- C. Fair Share – Nick Bedway: Not in attendance
- D. Development – Roxanne Smith, Patty Moore and Carol Suder-Howes: Since WV TRiO Association purchased the Galaxy Tablets for College Goal Sundays which did not take place due to inclement weather, the Development committee was using it as 50/50 and raffle ticket prizes at this conference. The committee is also calling for more members to serve and contribute ideas for development. A question was raised as to whether businesses or corporations had been approached to help with development.
- E. Archives – Terri Philpott: Ms. Philpott has retired. Will need members to step up to take her place.
- F. Governmental Relations - Angela Holley: 1. Current issues being discussed at Congress include the \$60 million increase in TRiO funding. Ms. Holley encouraged all members to call their senators and representatives' offices to ask for the increase. 2. EOC and TS comment periods are open. Ms. Holley encouraged all to post comments. 3. Policy Seminar will take place on March 6-8, 2016. March 7 is when members walk the Hill. Members were reminded that grant funds could not be used for attending the Policy Seminar.

VII. New Business

- A. Tax Exempt Status – as reported above, the status will be restored soon.
- B. Emerging Leaders – Thanks to Ms. Angela Holley and Scott Robertson who conducted several workshops at this conference to provide training for seasoned and new TRiO personnel, the powerpoint presentations will be put on the WV TRiO Association website after the conference.
- C. College Goal Sunday – Tablets & Amazon Gift Cards: College Goal Sunday will be held on Feb. 21, 2016. Volunteers will be needed for that day.
- D. 15th Annual Student Leadership Conference – Members voted on the locations and dates proposed by President Elect Robertson. Choice 1: Flatwoods on April 1-3, 2016, and Choice 2: Holiday Inn (Charleston Convention Center) on Feb. 5-7 or March 18-20. Members voted by a show of hands to favor Choice 1. Rooms are \$95 each and can accommodate up to 4 people. There is no minimum or maximum number of students each program could bring. Paradigm Shift will handle the whole conference. There will be one track for pre-college students and another for college students.
- E. Development Items – an announcement was made to encourage members to participate in 50/50 and raffle ticket purchase. Money raised will be put into the Scholarship fund.
- F. WV TRiO Day-State Initiatives – TRiO Day is usually held on the last Saturday of Feb. An idea was suggested to send Thank You card to senators and representatives for supporting TRiO programs.
- G. 2016 WV TRiO Fact book – Each program staff was recommended to send in program data to Nick Bedway for the View Book, which is taken to the Hill during Walk the Hill activity in March. A question was raised whether past View Books could be seen on the association website. The answer is yes. The 2014 View Book is there.
- H. 2016 Walk the Hill – see above
- I. New WV TRiO Logo – a contest has been announced for TRiO student participants to submit their design for prizes of a \$250 Scholarship and a Tablet. Submissions must be completed by March 1, 2016 to wvtrio@gmail.com in pdf format.
- J. Elections – Only one nomination had been received for President-Elect: Angela Holley. President-Elect Robertson called for floor nominations and received none. Henceforth, there was no need to vote. Ms. Angela Holley became the President-Elect for 2015-2016 year.
- K. WVASPA Membership
- L. TRiO Partnership with Americorp – Angela Holley informed members that partnering with Americorp would be a great idea for all TRiO programs. Kelly Jo McNemar of WVU is the one to contact about this.

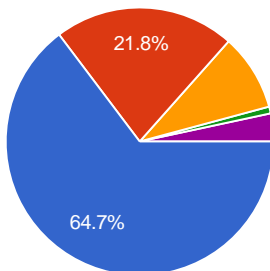

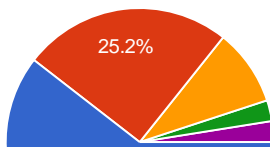

Community Service Project



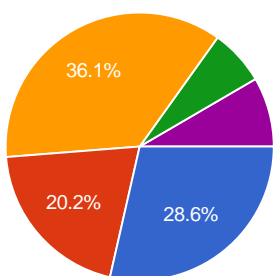

Anne Crum Leadership Banquet



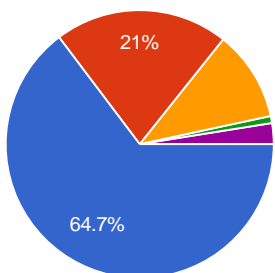

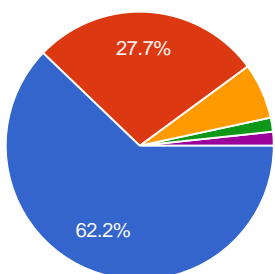

Sunday's Paradigm Shift Sessions



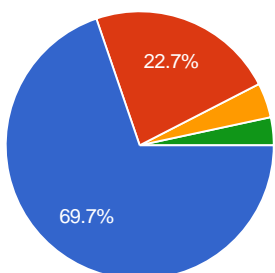
